SHADE LOVING PLANTS

Different plants will grow in varying amounts of shade. Plants that would normally bloom in full sun will probably grow in shade, but they won't bloom or look as good as they would in the sun. Full shade is usually defined as either no sun, or only a few hours of indirect light each day. Half shade would be either morning sun for 2-4 hours or filtered sun all day long.
